A Marie Antoinette–inspired hideaway with a secret entrance? It doesn't get more romantic than that. Behind a bookshelf inside the beloved neighborhood spot Chez Moi is a staircase that leads to this rococo-inspired bar and eatery with small plates like frogs' legs and pâté. You can eat a full meal upstairs at Chez Moi (V-Day menu [here](#)) and then afterward, head downstairs to share the Cocktail Pour Doux (\$25) made with tequila, hibiscus syrup, vanilla, lemon and star anise and served in an ornate glass as well as chocolate fondue, served with seasonal fruits and housemade cookies.
